The culmination of two weeks of rehearsals and feedback exchange, *Two on Two [2/2]* offers a rare opportunity to see “works in process” by two veterans of The Kitchen’s popular Dance in Progress series. The third installment of *Two on Two* features works by choreographers **Sarah Michelson** and **David Thomson**. Sarah Michelson performs her first solo, *Grivdon*, “a concert hall dance for a tiny tiny blade of grass.” David Thomson presents *Forest*, “a series of solos in process following an ongoing permutation of materials.”

**Sarah Michelson** has worked in New York with such choreographers as DD Dorvillier, Jennifer Monson, Paige Martin, Miguel Gutierrez, Chameki/Lerner, Julie Atlas Muz, Mike Iveson, Sarah East Johnson and others. She is currently the editor in chief of *The Movement Research Journal* and is a Yoga teacher certified by Dana Flynn.

**David Thomson**, has had the privilege of working with over thirty diverse artists and companies including Mel Wong, Jane Comfort, Bebe Miller, Michael Dinwiddie, Wendy Perron, Remy Charlip, Lee Nagrin, Susan Rethorst, Irene Hultman, David Rousseve, Robert Wilson, Laurie Anderson, Ralph Lemon, Michel Laub/Remote Control and the Lavender Light Gospel Choir. From 1987-93, as a member of Trisha Brown Company, he toured extensively throughout the United States, Europe, Asia and the former Soviet Union. Thompson has performed downtown, off-Broadway, and in London’s West End with the acclaimed a cappella performance group Hot Mouth, of which he is founding member. He is the 2001 Bessie Award recipient for Sustained Achievement.
