Artist Amy Taubin will present Interim Adviso (subject(s) to change), at The Kitchen Center, opening Tuesday, January 10th through 14th. The work is in two parts: a video installation, (Tues-Sat 1-6) and a performance (8:30 Jan. 13 & 14).

The installation, Exercises in the Reassignment of Words, consists of video tape documents of situations in which several men were asked to read writings by women.

The performance, Performance which began with a train ride on which the rider realized, but not until the last moments, that she had been seated facing backwards, uses a written text, video and several performers.

It is concerned with the nature and location of the exchange which takes place between performers and audience and how this exchange can be subverted and redefined so that a woman can perform without reinforcing, by this action, one of the primary structures of the patriarchal society, the exchange of women by men. It is also concerned with the spatial definition of a written text.

Amy Taubin has performed works of her own making at Anthology Film Archives and at Artists Space in New York City, and she is a regular film critic for the SoHo Weekly News. Her films are distributed by Filmmakers Coop, New York City.
