In 1970 she came to the United States and for the following three years worked in New York at School of the Arts, at Iowa Institute and at California Institute of the Arts. Her principal compositions include Chry-ptus (1971), 7th Birth (1972), Geelriandre (1972), 847 (1973), Triptych (1980) and Adnos II (1980). Internationally known, Ms. Radigue has presented her work at the Pavillon Francais of Expo '70 in Osaka, at Festival of Como (Italy, 1970), at Exposition Sonore in Paris (1972), Fondation Maeght in 1973 and the Kitchen in 1973.

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
