The Kitchen and Fashion Moda present twelve hours of live and DJ'd music at Fashion Moda in the Bronx. The bands include ALFONIA TIMMS and his FLYING TIGERS, RICO and the JAZZ MASTERS and Y PANTS.

Not aloof from the contemporary struggle both ALFONIA TIMMS and his FLYING TIGERS and RICO and the JAZZ MASTERS personify the nexus between the truth and the unknown. There are, of course, many definitions of Jazz, but the truth is these cats are BAD, BAD, BAD.

You can see the Jazz Masters Tuesday nights at Studio Ten and most weekends in Washington Square Park. Alfonia Timms has studied with James Blood Ulmer, Ornette Coleman, and is currently a member of the Oliver Lake Band.

Y Pants is amplified toy rock. The instrumentation is toy piano (GAIL VACHON), ukelele and bass guitar (BARBARA ESS) and drums (VERGE PIERSOL). The toy piano and ukelele go through sound devices (tremolo and phase shifter) creating an unusual sound that has been described as "underwater oriental" and as "science fiction with a strong beat".

As for the DJs, there will be assorted South Bronx "hip-hop" DJing and DAN GRAHAM.

Dan Graham, artist, has appeared twice as a guest DJ at the Mudd Club, for the Just Another Asshole benefit and with Static. This spring he gave a talk on "New Wave and Feminism" in Boston. His article entitled, "Punk", Post 'Political' 'Pop'" appeared in 1969 in the LAICA journal. Mr. Graham is presently designing the album cover for the forthcoming LP by Glenn Branca.
