Ashley has spent a long and notable career expanding the possibilities of music theatre, building his works on multiple layers of computer-manipulated language (from sources as disparate as "The Tibetan Book of the Dead" and Forbes magazine), music, movement, and imagery; the results can be as weirdly lyrical as they are provocative. For his latest opera, he turns his attention to the language of elderly people; his performers—most of them longtime colleagues—include such prominent avant-garders as the singers
