THE KITCHEN:

"PIONEERS OF THE DOWNTOWN SOUND"

The storied lower-Manhattan center for avant garde performance has no plans to move to Brooklyn—yet. Proud of its heritage, the venue has given the experimentalist icon Rhys Chatham two concerts in which to conjure up the sounds of the nineteen-seventies—including music by Tony Conrad, Pauline Oliveros, and Joan La Barbara.
