SEASON START

The Kitchen, that center for video, music and dance that has become an institution of the avant-garde, starts this season's contemporary-music series tonight in its one-flight-up quarters at 484 Broome Street, near Wooster Street (925-3615).

The opener is a collaborative concert by John Cale and Bob Neuwirth with Ruskin Germino. Mr. Cale, once described as a "godfather of the new wave" and formerly a member of the Velvet Underground, will be featured on piano, vocals, viola and guitar. He will be joined by Mr. Neuwirth, an early associate of Bob Dylan who is also a visual artist, on guitar and vocals. Mr. Germino will accompany on tenor saxophone.

Mr. Cale and Mr. Neuwirth have performed together once before, and on this program they will present their new works. The Concerts are tonight and tomorrow night at 8:30 and Saturday at 8:30 and 10:30 P.M. Admission is \$6.
