Untitled (Hold), 2010

A telephone call placed on hold is internally routed between 3 extensions in The Kitchen's offices, automatically forwarding the call from one to another in an endless cycle. The call will remain on hold for the duration of the exhibition, after which it will either be transferred to a new location or hung up/answered. The latter will cause the work to cease to exist.

Sean Raspet

Untitled (Sublet), 2010

A 28 x 84 inch rectangle of floor space (the size of a standard casket) subletted by the artist from The Kitchen at a pro-rated market rate on an ongoing basis. The work continues for as long as sublet payments are made, and may be transferred to another location in the future. If a payment is missed the piece ceases to exist.
