At the start of his fourth year of programming, Mr. Bowes has organized a retrospective screening of videotapes about which he feels most strongly:

> There were nights when the house was packed; hot nights, 250+ people, ten monitors glaring, with sound cranked to full. There were also cold nights in February, two people in the house with snow blowing through the window cracks. I'd wonder about the audiences and the differences between the two shows. Was it the pr tion? Was it the economy? Was it the publicity? Was it the presenta-Was it the weather?

> One thing is clear, the size of the audiences did not depend on the quality of the material. It was something else. I've watched compelling T.V. with few people in the house and had tedious moments with a full audience.

So here's another chance. Decide for yourself. the material which I like the best. It's a body of work which deserves attention and certainly a second look.


