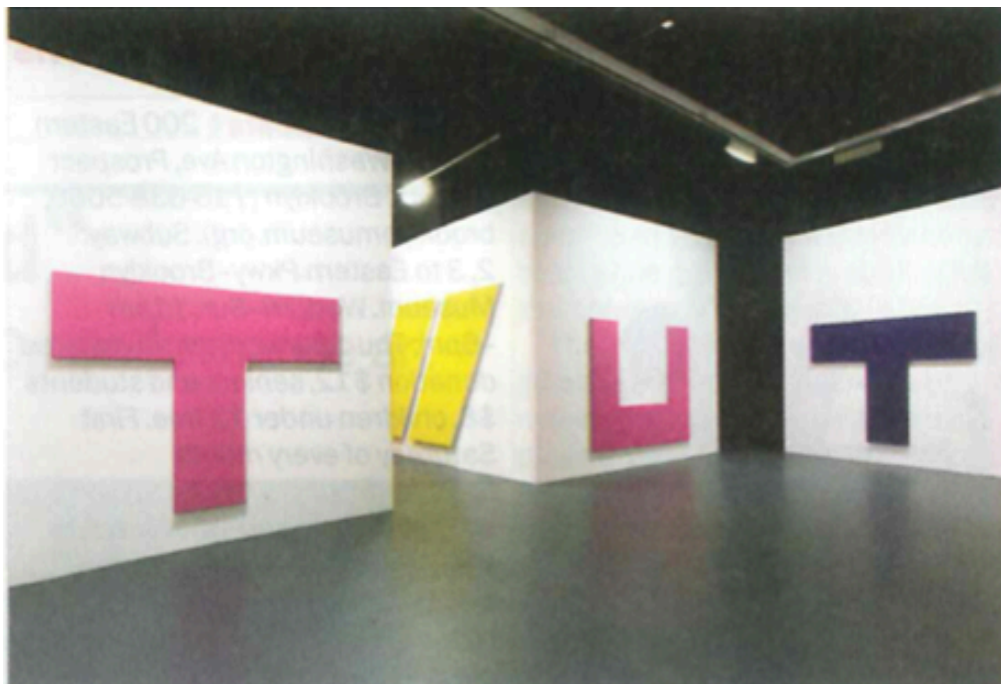

This veteran Swiss artist, who currently calls Tucson, Arizona, home, started out in late-'60s Paris as part of a group of conceptually oriented painters that included Daniel Buren. He subsequently spent time in New York, where his signature monochromatic paintings were regularly exhibited during the 1970s and '80s.
