On Tuesday, March 13 The Kitchen will present readings by Lynne Tillman and Kelvin James.

Lynne Tillman's novel, "Haunted Houses," came out in 1987 from Poseidon Press. This May, "Absence Makes the Heart," a collection of her short fiction, including her first novel "Weird Fucks," will be published in the United Kingdom by Serpent's Tail. She is the co-director and writer of the independent feature film Committed. Tillman's critical writing appears in Art in America, the Village Voice, the New York Times Book Review and Artforum. She is a frequent contributor to Bomb, Between C & D and the Portable Lower East Side. She has recently finished another novel entitled "Motion Sickness."

Kelvin James is a challenging new voice from the Harlem literary community. At present he has completed two short story collections and is at work on a new novel. His first collection of short stories is being represented by the Lantz Office. In 1985 he co-founded "A Literary Salon," a multi-cultural reading series dedicated to presenting new works of fiction and poetry by emerging writers, presented through Yomoma Arts, Inc. His work has appeared in Between C & D, and Bomb. In 1989 he was awarded a New York Foundation for the Arts fellowship in fiction.
