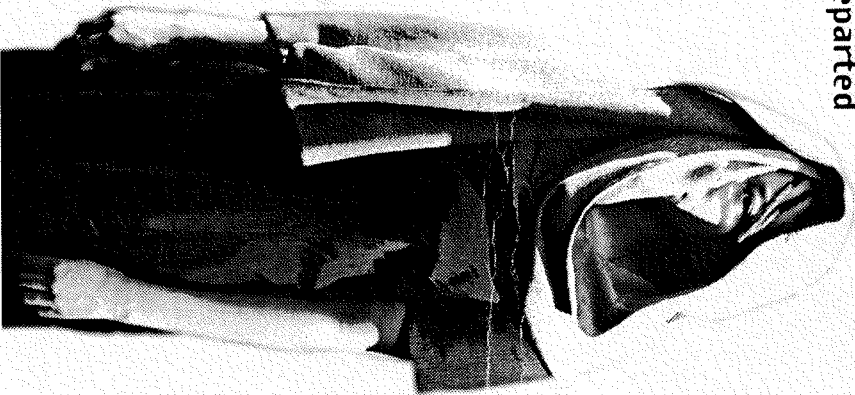

Tracing the lives of Africans accused of conspiracy in 18th century New York to the terrible deaths of Eddie Perry, Eleanor Bumpurs and Michael Stewart—African-Americans killed by police brutality—*The Negros Burial Ground* is a touching tribute to those who have lost their lives in the name of freedom.
