Two Novelists on Two Artists



FREDERIC TUTEN, director of the Graduate Program in Literature and Creative Writing at City College (New York), is the author of three novels: *The Adventures of Mao on the Long March*, *Tallien: A Brief Romance* and *Tintin in the New World: A Romance*.



WALTER MOSLEY is the author of the acclaimed Easy Rawlins mystery series, beginning with *Devil in a Blue Dress* (the movie of which will be released September 22 by Tristar), followed by *A Red Death*, *White Butterfly* and last year's *New York Times* bestseller, *Black Betty*. This month marks the introduction of another Mosley character, Socrates, with short story publications in *Buzz*, July's *Esquire* and August's *GQ*. Also in August, W.W.Norton will publish Mosley's first non-mystery novel, *R.L.'s Dream*, a blues novel about an aging guitarist who got his start playing with the legendary Robert Johnson.
