Imaginary Landscapes: The Kitchen continues its exciting festival of electronic music, but leave your preconceptions of what that term means at home. Shelley Hirsch, whose stream-of-consciousness dramatic singing is as original as anything downtown, performs with David Weinstein's synthesizers (March 3); Alvin Lucier will play an electronic bird, Gordon Monahan will swing speakers to create doppler shifts (March 4); Blue Gene Tyranny and Laetitia deCompiegne will mix boogie-woogie, high-tech, and pastoral imagery (March 5); and the Swiss duo Voice Crack will make their first New York appearance, producing walls of sound from cheap radio components (March 6).
