The New York-Based Company the Village Voice Described as "generous, eloquent (and) poetic," Presents its 1996 Season of New Works

WHO: Zvi Gotheiner & Dancers was founded in 1989 by Israeli-born choreographer Zvi Gotheiner and has performed internationally to critical acclaim. The company recently participated in the Soho Arts Festival and has performed at The Joyce, Lincoln Center Out-of-Doors, The American Dance Festival and Posthof Linz. Following The Kitchen performances the company will leave for their third European tour. The work is a collaboration between Zvi Gotheiner & Dancers and the composer Scott Killian.

WHAT: 6 x 6 features six solos for men and a group work for 6 dancers. The group work is a modern folk story about malice and punishment, a community united by violence, inspired by the cycles of order and redemption in the Aramaic folk song "Chad Gad Ya," the violent justice of film noir and the militant control of fascist propaganda. The work is performed by June Balish, Edna de Beer, Elisa King, Jonathan Riseling, Richard Siegal and Valeric Vann. The male solos were created for six unique talents, representing a personal collaborative effort between dancer and choreographer. Each solo explores a different element of masculinity in motion and will be performed by Peter Anzalone, Gerald Casel, Steven Ochoa, Dirk Platzek, Jonathan Riseling and Richard Siegal.

WHERE: The Kitchen, 512 West 19th Street in the West Chelsea District of Manhattan.

WHEN: Performances are March 1 at 8pm, March 2 at 2pm & 8pm and March 3 at 7pm. Tickets are \$15. Benefactor tickets are available at \$35 (for information or reservations, please call Tamara Greenfield at 925-1466. A *Conversation with the Artist* will follow the Saturday matinee performance.
