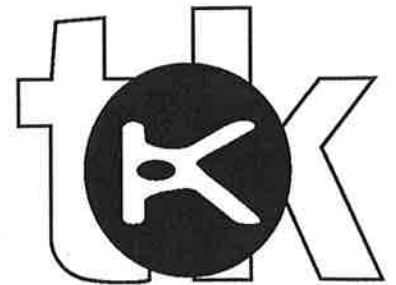

Alchemy in the Kitchen Money: The Split Within

Following her sold-out performance in December,
Lloraine Neithardt presents the second in her performance/lecture series
at The Kitchen on January 22, 8pm.

As we approach the next millennium, artists and philosophers search for new forms of knowledge to spark creativity. Lloraine Neithardt presents her thoughts on the development of a creative renaissance. This installment in her series **Alchemy in the Kitchen** deals with money and how it effects our lives. As much creativity and effort is put into manifesting poverty as well as its opposite. The unconscious split image within will determine the result. Tracing the original female principle behind money, bringing it forth from the shadow, where it rules, to a conscious creative expression. The first in this series, *Opus 22: Envy*, was presented to a capacity crowd on December 4th.

Lloraine Neithardt is an internationally recognized visionary who has had the remarkable privilege of assisting thousands of individuals become conscious of the soul-making process. She endeavors to enable each person she counsels to know, accept and work with the creative aspects of their destiny. Through countless sessions Neithardt has conducted, she has been exposed to the psyches of innumerable individuals. The outcome is her observation of an emerging pattern—people's unconscious urge to discover their own wholeness. Her belief is that this pattern is just now beginning to take form in a collective renaissance through which mysticism and science will unite. Over the past 25 years, Neithardt has studied esoteric sciences, leading her to a conscious relationship with soul. She has discerned that her own creative contribution is to spread the word that a renaissance is fast approaching. To accomplish her obligation, she intends to nudge, push, inspire and even frighten.

The final installment in this series, *Womanchrist*, will take place on March 26th at 8pm.
