Charles Atlas is a filmmaker and video artist who has worked extensively with media and dance. His recent pieces include Jump (1984), made in France with choreographer Philippe Decoufle and awarded first prize in videodance competition sponsored by French Ministry of Culture; Island Summer (1983-84), a diary film of summer in the city which includes two dancing days with Karole Armitage; Parafango (1984-84), a video/dance/music work with a contemporary narrative thread made with Karole Armitage and David Linton; Times Five for Merce (1983), a five channel video work shown as a 20 monitor installation at the Centre Georges Pompidou in Paris; and Secret of the Water-fall (1983), a mix of videotape and poetry made with Douglass Dunn and poets Reed Bye and Anne Waldman. Current projects include Ex-Romance, a film shot for WGBH-TV, on location in an airport in Providence, Rhode Island in which contemporary dance by Karole Armitage is played against movie musical conventions; a video collaboration with comic performance artist Bill Irwin for PBS; and a video opera for French television.
