MADE IN EUROPE

Daily video exhibition April 20-24 1pm-6pm / 484 Broome Street

Over the past several years there have emerged in Europe a few video facilities for independent production by artists working in videotape. This show at the Kitchen is comprised of tapes made mostly through art/tapes/22 an organization in Florence directed by Maria Gloria Bicocchi. Art/tapes/22 has become known as a place where European artists as well as American artists travelling in Europe can go and under most hospitable conditions produce video art work.

Because of the poor quality and expense involved in the transfer of videotapes from the European to the American television standard, most videotapes made in Europe are rarely seen in this country.

We are very pleased at the Kitchen to present this show on our dual standard European/ American video cassette player. Showing the videotapes in the standard in which they were originally produced ensures the highest possible playback quality.

Artists represented in the show include Vito Acconci, Christian Boltanski, Guisepppe Chiari, Jon Gibson, Gilbert and George, Dickie Landry, Alvin Lucier, Charlemagne Palestine. We are very grateful to Anna Canepa, Castelli-Sonnabend, Bill Viola, art/tapes/22, and the individual artists for their help in realizing this exhibition.
