VITO ACCONCI 3 INSTALLATIONS

From February 16th through March 15th, The Gallery at The Kitchen will present three installations by Vito Acconci.

Until recently, Acconci's installations have been built into a space, developing from the particular characteristics of that space. Currently, the installations are more like vehicles passing through a space and stopped by that space, or like devices that can be hooked onto a space.

At The Kitchen, three examples of the newer work will be shown. Two of the pieces have sound, one with speakers and one with headphones. WHEN THE NEW REVOLUTION COMES provides furniture for a room; INSTANT HOUSE provides a room within a room; MOVABLE FLOOR provides a base and transportation for a room. Each piece functions as an instrument of decoration and propaganda.

Vito Acconci is represented by Sonnabend Gallery. Recently he has had shows at the Kunstmuseum Luzern and the Stedelijk Museum in Amsterdam; he will have a retrospective at the Chicago Museum of Contemporary Art in March 1980.
