Saturday, October 30 at 8:30 pm, The Oliver Lake Quartet will perform at The Kitchen. Oliver Lake, composer and saxophonist from St. Louis, will present Colors, a concert of new compositions. The Quartet is Oliver Lake- alto saxophone; Michael Gregory Jackson-guitar; Fred Hopkins-bass and Paul Maddox-drums.

Lake frames expressions of measured lyricism or charged dramatic intensity within spare, transparent structures... there is also a strong sense of the elemental (and invocational), organically flowing force that one associates with artists like Sam Rivers. In addition, a deep blues undercurrent tugs Lake's sharp biting tone into snarls, shouts, cries and whispers of a raw if sharply focussed intensity: fire and ice...
