The performance will last 2½ hours. There will be <u>no</u> intermission. Feel free to get up and <u>quietly</u> move around if you need to. Tea will be served mid-way through the performance.

Chinoiserie is a verbal decoration for four characters who are playing Mah Jong and Talking. Mah Jong is a Chinese game that is played with tiles. Players call out the names of the tiles they are discarding, and call out "pung," "chow," or "kong," when they can complete a set by taking one of the tiles discarded by another player. The call of "ready," by a player means that she is one tile from completing a winning hand. The first player to complete a perfect hand calls "Mah Jong" wins the hand, and is then paid by the other players on the basis of how many "points" are awarded to the winning hand.
