A painter, performance artist, and video maker, **Jose Alvarez** is known for his charismatic performances in which he “channeled” the 2,000-year-old spirit of the shaman Carlos in front of live audiences and in media broadcasts across the globe. For his first New York solo exhibition, he presents a powerful combination of newly created videos, paintings, works-on-paper, and photography that explore how the unfolding of psychic hoaxes, the perceived supernatural energy of charmed objects, and the mysterious quests underlying space exploration all connect to the strong human desire for knowledge and transformation.
