The Black Panther Ballet Suite* at The Kitchen (512 West 19th Street 255-5793). Composer Fred Ho and the Afro Asian Music Ensemble combine soul, jazz, and West African music into a piece as radical as its subject. On screens that surround the musicians, digital videos by Scott Marshall and Paul Chan animate newspaper stories from the height of the Black Panther Party. After the show, there will be a reception celebrating Fred Ho's latest double CD, an opera about Assata Shakur, called *Warrior Sisters: The New Adventures of African and Asian Womyn Warriors*. The shows are on February 12 and 13 at 8 pm. Tickets are \$15. An open dress rehearsal at 4 pm on February 12 is part of the Kids in the Kitchen series. For \$5, it's a great way to introduce your brood to the revolutionary vanguard.
