Biographies

Linda Hill is a writer, actress, comic, and improvisor who has been seen on PBS Comedy Tonight, George Carlin's apt. 2C on HBO, with Don Novello a.k.a. Father Guido Sarducci on Cinemax and Comedy Central's 2 Drink Minimum. She has performed at Cucaracha Theater, The Vineyard, Samuel Beckett, and the Joseph Papp Public Theater to name a few. Her solo works include An audience with Linda Hill, Incognito Sex, Hope in Kansas, Angel Spreads Her Wings, and Too Many Clothes which debuted last year at The Kitchen. She has two videos coming out, a video dream poem titled Sacred Sex, and in the fall, Portrait of a Sinner, a mockumentary about the life of Miss Angel Drake. This is the world premier of Star 69.

Dave Simonds is the co-founder of Cucaracha Theater and served as its associate director for ten years. He co-created the Cucaracha Warehouse Cabaret which featured the work of Phoebe Legere, Holly Hughes, Paul Zaloom, Blue Man Group, and the late Ethyl Eichelberger among many others. He coordinated the popular Underground Soap. He wrote and directed his plays Artlife and Storm Patterns as well as dozens of one acts. Lately he has directed the performer Dale Goodson at Surf Reality, Dixon Place and Westbeth. As an actor David has performed in a gazillion plays at Cucaracha and elsewhere. Film credits include Amateur, Sudden Manhattan, Urban Legend, Cardiac, The Refrigerator, Peacemaker, Conspiring Theory. TV credits include NY Undercover and The Conan O'Brian Show. David is happy to be working with The Kitchen again where he was last seen in 1984 hanging from the ceiling in a rabbit suit in a piece by Diane Martel.

Since 1976 **Anney Bonney** has lived and worked in New York City as a painter, videographer, and installation artist. Her first film, *Pygmalion Alien* (an animated short), won a NYSCA grant and her Super 8 films played in clubs downtown (Mudd, 57, Stilwend, Global Village,...), as well as at the Ford Foundation. Last year The Kitchenette at the Thread Waxing Space exhibited *Confabulating Chaos*, a video temple to liquid memory, and The Kitchen premiered *Neptune Rising*, her homage to Jimi Hendrix at its Spring Benefit.
