DAVID SHEA born 1965, studied at the Indianapolis School of Performing Arts from 1981-83, and The Oberlin Conservatory from 1984-85. Since 1984 he has been an active composer performer, improviser, organizer and club DJ. He has also played with many of the musicians involved in the downtown free improvisation scene such as: Anthony Coleman, Chris Cochrane, Shelly Hirsch, Zeena Parkins, and many others. He is a frequent player in many of John Zorn's ensembles. His work has been presented in N.Y.C. at Roulette, P.S. 122, DTW, The Knitting Factory, St. Mark's Church and A Mica Bunker. Other U.S. dates have included The Walker Arts Center in Minneapolis, and Lowerlinks in Chicago, and he has recently completed a European solo tour. He has composed extensively for dance collaborating with Karole Armitage. Barbara Hoffrening, Neta Pulvermacher, Risa Jareslow and James Adlesic. Among other collaborations David Shea has worked with sign language artist Beth Lipton, video artist David Bryant, environmental scientist Ken Greenberg, and an unusual collaboration with fashion designer Betsy Johnson. He co-directed ABC No Rio from 1988-89, was the performance director of Chameleon in 1990, and has curated programs at Tin Pan Alley and P.S. 122. David Shea is also active as a club DJ at Kilimanjaro, The Pyramid Club, Mars, Hotel Amazon and The Village Gate.
