This charismatic flutist performs works commissioned as part of Density 2036, a 22-year venture whose title is inspired by the 100th anniversary (in 2036) of Edgard Varèse's flute solo "Density 21.5." On Tuesday, she plays works by Steve Reich, Alvin Lucier, Philip Glass, Marcos Balter and Mario Diaz de Leon; the lineup on Wednesday features music by George Lewis, Matthias Pintscher, Felipe Lara and Du Yun; and the three-part series wraps up Friday with a program of Nathan Davis, Jason Eckardt, Dai Fujikura, Pauline Oliveros and Francesca Verunelli. *Vivien Schweitzer*
