Rashaad Newsome's videos, performances, sculptures, and photographs investigate the notion of cultural signifiers as well as how they are formed and evolve. Using the equalizing force of sampling he crafts compositions that frequently surprise in their associative potential and walk the tightrope between identity politics and abstraction. Newsome picks these structures apart and recombines them, eliciting emotional and visceral responses that can be universally recognized and felt. Rashaad Newsome was born in New Orleans, Louisiana where he received a B.A. in Art History at Tulane University before studying Film at Film Video Arts in New York City. Newsome has exhibited nationally and internationally at such creditable institutions and galleries as The Project Gallery, New York, NY; Glassbox Gallery, Paris, France; and The Veletrzni Palace, Prague, Czech Republic. Recent awards include 2009 BAC Community Arts Regrant and 2009 Harvestworks Van Lier Grant, Harvestworks, New York, NY. Upcoming projects in 2009 include new commissions for The McColl Center for Visual Art's, Charlotte, NC and The North Carolina Dance Theatre.

Kalup Linzy is a New York-based video and performance artist best known for a series of video art pieces satirizing the tone and narrative approach of television soap opera. Linzy performs most of the characters himself, many in drag, and also performs on stage using many of the same characters. Linzy has exhibited his work at P.S.1 Contemporary Arts Center, Long Island City, NY; The Hayward Gallery, London; and Musée d'Art Moderne de la Ville de Paris. In 2008, he received a Creative Capital grant, a Jerome Foundation fellowship, an Art Matters grant, and was honored as a finalist for the William H. Johnson grant.

Linzy is represented by Taxter & Spengemann in New York. In 2003, Linzy graduated from the MFA program at the University of

South Florida and attended the Skowhegan School of Painting and Sculpture video art workshop.
